

Shuffleboard Table Rules and Regulations

- 1. NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 IS PERMITTED TO PLAY!**
- 2. PLEASE KEEP YOUR HANDS-OFF PLAYING SURFACE AS THE OILS ON OUR SKIN AFFECT THE TABLE!**
- 3. Nothing is to be placed on the Shuffleboard table, except the pucks.**
- 4. Choose an official scorekeeper who will maintain the score, throughout the entire game.**

One (1) hour time limit per group (either 2 or 4 people). If no one else is waiting to play you can stay on table.

Sign in on the Wipeboard to play next game. Please erase your name when finished.

If someone is waiting to play, the winner of the previous match may remain playing with the next two-some, this is how it works in Official Tournaments and Taverns!

If you are the last person using it will be your responsibility to put the cover back on the Shuffleboard table. The playing pucks will need to be left at either end of the table.

As a resident it's your responsibility to make certain that everyone who is using the table is playing for a friendly game and that there the table is not being mistreated.
